The regulation mandates full traceability of commodities such as wood, cattle, soy, and palm oil, along with comprehensive due diligence documentation throughout the supply chain. The team built a system that enabled compliance for IKEA retailers purchasing goods both from Inter IKEA and through locally procured products, ensuring traceability and regulatory adherence across the entire supply chain.

In addition to the migration work, the team was responsible for establishing guidelines and frameworks for how teams within the broader ERP program should work with Power BI and MS Fabric, ensuring consistency, quality and best practices across the organization.
